

PRIZE BIOCHEMICAL ANALYSIS 2015

The German Society for Clinical Chemistry and Laboratory Medicine (DGKL, Deutsche Vereinte Gesellschaft für Klinische Chemie und Laboratoriumsmedizin e.V.) awards the Biochemical Analysis Prize for outstanding scientific research in the field of biochemical and molecular analysis.

The prize, established in 1970, is awarded for advancements in the field of biochemical and molecular analysis methods and for significant novel scientific findings achieved with modern analytical methods in the area of biological sciences, especially in clinical chemistry and clinical biology. Biochemical analysis comprises methods of analytical chemistry whose techniques are based on biochemical reactions and/or reagents of biological origin.

Furthermore, it includes methodical and instrument-based systems, especially those of instrumental analysis, that enable determination of biological parameters and parameters which engage in biological processes. The list of previous awardees includes 5 scientists who later received the Nobel Prize in their field (see www.DGKL.de).

The Prize Biochemical Analysis 2015 is endowed with 50.000 € and promoted by Sarstedt AG & Co. The prize will be awarded during the 12th Congress of the German Society for Clinical Chemistry and Laboratory Medicine in Leipzig, 14th – 17th October 2015.

Suitable candidates may apply themselves or can be nominated by others.

The following documents must be submitted:

- Scientific curriculum vitae
- Summary of the complete scientific work (maximal two page)
- complete copies of publication(s) on which the proposal is based
- a short list of five key publications

The deadline for the application is July 15th, 2015.
